CITY OF GARNER COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS UNAPPROVED MINUTES DECEMBER 3, 2019

The City of Garner Council met in special session on Tuesday, December 3, 2019 at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Mayor Mick called the meeting to order at 5:35pm.

ROLL CALL-Present: Don Bell, Denny Drabek, Marline Lewerke, Tim Schmidt, and Lynn Smith, Absent: none.

Also in attendance was Drew Sweers from V&K, Director of Parks & Rec Kaitlyn Sorenson and Council-elect Glen Juhl.

Motion by Denny Drabek, seconded by Marline to accept the agenda as printed, carried unanimously.

CA Kofoed gave an update on the City's 2019 Goals and Accomplishments. Kaitlyn Sorenson reviewed the P&R Departments 2020 goals. Trends, challenges and department equipment needs were all discussed. CA Kofoed plans to review the 2020 priorities set with the Council in six months. The following priorities were then established:

2020 Top Priorities:

1. Complete the Pool Park Shelter House

2. Complete Hejlik's Third Subdivision
3. Complete the Highway 18 Trail Project
4. Remain Financially Sound
5. Complete the Sanitary Sewer Telescoping Project
6. Continue to Work with Developers on housing opportunities
7. Continue with the Street Overlay Program
8. Do a core test on State Street to evaluate future reconstruction

2-5 year Priorities:

1. Consider additional land for future housing developments including Hejlik's Fourth Subdivision
2. Continue with the Sidewalk Program
3. Work towards constructing a community center at the Golf Course
4. Dog park and/or a sports complex
5. Set aside funds for the State Street renovation project

With no further business, there was a motion by Tim Schmidt, seconded by Marline Lewerke to adjourn the meeting at 8:07pm.
