CITY OF GARNER COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS UNAPPROVED MINUTES March 30, 2020

The City of Garner Council met in special session via "GoToMeeting.com" on Monday March 30, 2020 at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers at City Hall. In support of Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds' proclamation declaring a State of Public Health Disaster Emergency in Iowa, the current COVID-19 Pandemic situation makes it impractical and impossible to conduct an in-person meeting at Garner City Hall to conduct City business.

Mayor Ken Mick called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

Motion by Marline Lewerke, seconded by Glen Juhl to approve the agenda as printed, carried unanimously.

After an update on the COVID-19 Pandemic by Adam Kofoed a motion by Tim Schmidt, seconded by Marline Lewerke to approve Resolution 2020-13a AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPROVE PAID EMPLOYEE LEAVE DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, ayes: Don Bell, Denny Drabek, Glen Juhl, Marline Lewerke, and Tim Schmidt, nays: None.

After discussion regarding the impact

COVID-19 could potentially have on City Employees a motion by Don Bell, seconded by Glen Juhl to approve Resolution 2020-14 AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO COORDINATE SKELETON CREW SHIFTS TEMPORARILY TO REDUCE THE EXPOSURE OF COVID-19 IN GARNER, ayes: Don Bell, Denny Drabek, Glen Juhl, and Marline Lewerke, nays: Tim Schmidt

A motion by Marline Lewerke, seconded by Don Bell to approve Resolution 2020-15 ALLOWING THE GARNER CITY COUNCIL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE TO DISPERSE DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO THE GARNER CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR BUSINESS SUPPORT; carried unanimously.

After discussion regarding the need for an extra brush pick up for Garner residents city council gave direction to Public Work Supervisor, Mark Waddingham, to pick up curbside brush on April 13th in addition to the monthly pick up on April 24th, weather permitting.

With no further business there was a motion by Denny Drabek, seconded by Marline Lewerke to adjourn the meeting at 6:49pm.
